Instructions and General Conditions

Kerala State Science and Technology Museum is an Autonomous organization, registered under Charitable Societies Act, established by the Govt. of Kerala for popularizing Science education to various sections of the society. This Museum is governed by a Governing Body chaired by the Hon'ble Minister for Higher Education. Science City, Kottayam is a project under Kerala State Science and Technology Museum.

1. Submission of tender

Tender shall be submitted in sealed cover, superscribed as **"Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract for Computers, peripherals and projectors installed at the Science Centre building of Science City, Kottayam."**

The cover shall contain the following:

- (a) Complete set of Tender documents as issued by the Kerala State Science and Technology Museum here in after referred to as "**Museum**" together with addenda/corrigenda if any, filled in and signed by the tenderer, with address stamps/seals wherever stipulated. The rate quoted shall be both in words and figures. In case of any mismatch between the two, the amount indicated in words will be considered correct.
- (b) Earnest money deposit of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) in the form of crossed demand draft drawn in favour of the Director, Kerala State Science and Technology Museum, Thiruvananthapuram payable at Thiruvananthapuram.

The offer shall be valid for a period of 45 days from the date of opening of the tender. Tender not accompanied by the E.M.D. shall be rejected as non-responsive.

2. Acceptance / Rejection of tenders

The tenders submitted after the stipulated time of submission shall be rejected. The tenders not submitted in the prescribed forms, not duly signed at the places marked, incomplete/torn off tender forms etc. shall be rejected. The Director, Kerala State Science and Technology Museum, Thiruvananthapuram reserves the right to accept or reject any of the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof. Becoming the lowest offered party does not entitle a tender to award the work. Apart from cost, quality of work, durability, track record of the contractor, guarantee offered etc. will also be considered for awarding the supply.

3. Scope, Place of work and period of contract.

The scope of the work covered by this tender is Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract for Computers, peripherals and projectors installed at the Science Centre building of science city, Kottayam. The tenderer is advised to visit the site before quoting. The period of contract shall be **One year**. The detailed scope of the work covered in the contract but not limited to shall be as follows:

- i) The maintenance service shall consist of preventive and corrective maintenance of the computers, peripherals and projectors installed at the Science Centre building of science city, Kottayam as listed in the schedule of work and shall include the supply and replacement of defective parts.
- ii) The removed parts shall be the property of the museum.
- iii) If any spare part module is beyond repair/service, the same shall be replaced with either equal or with better performance levels by the contractor
- iv) The Contractor shall attend the breakdown calls at the earliest and shall rectify the problem to keep minimal down time.
- v) The Contractor shall replace/ replenish the consumables like plastic parts, print heads, fuser assembly, fuser sleeve, drum unit, tone ink cartridges, plotter pen, hammer unit, UPS batteries etc.
- vi) The Contractor shall ensure any data loss from the systems while repairing.

4. Payment Terms

The AMC charges shall be paid on a quarterly basis. The Contractor shall submit the invoice in triplicate for 1/4th value of the contract amount at the end of each quarter. The Museum shall pay the quarterly amount within 15 days from the receipt of the invoice upon certification by the staff in charge.

5. Agreement for the work.

Within 7 working days of receipt of the letter of award, the awarded contractor shall execute an agreement with the Museum for the due fulfillment of the contract in the prescribed format.

6. Withdrawals of the offer after it is accepted, failure to execute the agreement within the stipulated period or failure to carry out the work prescribed in the schedule within the specified time to keep the minimal downtime of the equipment will entail cancellation of the order and work being made at the offerer's expenses from elsewhere, any loss incurred thereby being payable by the defaulting party. In such an event the Museum reserves the right to remove the defaulter's name from the list of Museum's vendors list and to report to the Government for blacklisting the tenderer in Government works permanently or for a specified number of years.
7. The rates quoted shall be firm for a period of 45 days from the date of opening of the tender. Rates offered shall be inclusive of **all taxes & duties in force at the time of tendering**. The details of the Computers, peripherals and projectors included under the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract are listed in the schedule of work. Any representation for enhancement of price will not be considered on any ground.
8. The tenderers are requested to visit the site and collect the required data from the staff-in-charge before submitting the tender.
9. The contractor shall keep the working premises and the surrounding areas neat and tidy.

10. All the debris generated from the work shall be cleared from the campus of Science City, Kottayam and disposed of at a convenient place identified by the contractor, including all charges of loading, conveyance and unloading. The Museum shall not take any responsibility in this regard.
11. All defects and faults notified to the Contractor by the Museum during the currency of the contract shall be rectified by the Contractor even after the period of contract without any extra cost to the Museum.
12. If any dispute between the two parties of contract arises during / after termination of the contract, such disputes will be referred to the Civil Courts, Thiruvananthapuram and such jurisdiction will be confined to the Courts in Thiruvananthapuram city only.
13. Any attempt on the part of tenderers or their agents to influence the officers concerned in their favour by personal canvassing will disqualify the tender.
14. Special conditions, if any, printed on the tender sheets by the tenderer or attached with the tender will not be applicable to the tender unless they are expressly accepted in writing by the Director, KSSTM.
