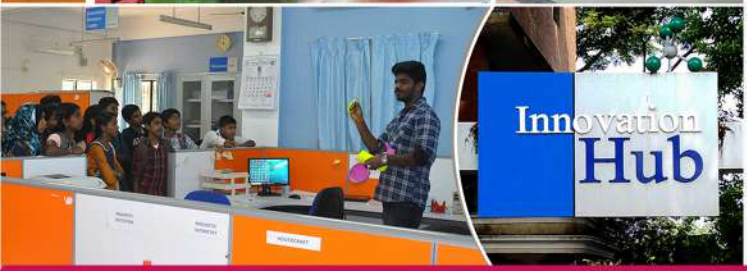

The Kerala State Science & Technology Museum, (KSSTM) Thiruvananthapuram is an Autonomous organisation, setup by the Government of Kerala in 1984, to serve as a dynamic medium of science communication for the public and inculcating a sense of inquiry and scientific temperament in the minds of the young. This is also a study cum reaction centre and an important tourist attraction.



## PRIYADARSINI PLANETARIUM



This is the most sophisticated and versatile Planetarium in India. The Planetarium reveals the wonder worlds of astronomy.

- » First Hybrid Planetarium in India with tilted, 17 metre diameter dome.
- » Provision for projecting starry night sky of any location of earth at any point of time using high versatile Opto-mechanical projector.
- » Immersive experience using full dome digital projector.

## 3D THEATRE



The museum has at present 8 Galleries communicating basics science and advanced technologies to common people through its various interactive exhibits. The Electronics gallery, Popular science gallery, Space gallery, Astronomy gallery, Mathematics and Robotics corner, Electrical engineering gallery etc. The Science park with evolution park, Medicinal plant garden, Butter fly park, Cactus park, Dinosaur park and Interactive Science Exhibits are the other major attractions. The Museum also houses a hybrid planetarium which aids in astronomy studies and a Science On Sphere (SOS) which facilitates Earth Studies. Facilities like Musical water fountain with Laser Show, 3D Theatre, Astronomical Observatory etc also add colour to the visitor experience.
