1. Applications are invited from qualified candidates for appointment to the following posts under Kerala State Science and Technology Museum, Thiruvananthapuram and its subcentres. Name of Post, Scale of Pay, probable number of vacancies and required qualifications are detailed below:

Age Limit: Candidate shall be within the age limit of 18 to 36 as on 01/01/2026. The maximum age limit shall be raised by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates. Differently abled candidates, Ex-service men and widow candidates are also eligible for relaxation in upper age limit as per rules,

subject to the condition that in no case the maximum age limit shall exceed 50 years.

II. General conditions regarding submission of applications

- 1) Application shall be submitted online to the Director, Kerala State Science and Technology Museum, Thiruvananthapuram in the format prescribed in the website of Kerala State Science and Technology Museum (www.kstmuseum.com)
- 2) The application fee shall be Rs.1,000/- for General candidates and Rs.500/- for candidates belonging to SC/ST Communities/Eligible Differently abled candidates for category No. 01/2025 to 03/2025. For all other category of posts the application fee shall be Rs.750/- for General candidates and Rs.375/- for candidates belonging to SC/ST Communities/Eligible Differently abled candidates. The mode of payment shall be through online only. Cash/DD/Money Order/Cheque etc. will not be accepted. The application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 3) Candidates employed in Central Government/ State Government/ Public Undertaking/Autonomous Bodies etc. shall obtain a certificate from the head of the Institution stating that the candidate shall be relieved from the Institution if selected. This should be submitted on demand.
- 4) All the applicants will be admitted provisionally for the examination. The original documents to prove qualifications, date of birth, community, disability etc. have to be produced for verification as and when called for. The applications of candidates without required educational qualifications and who are found not within the prescribed age limit, on verification will be rejected.
- 5) Candidates who claim equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification shall produce the relevant government order/ equivalency certificate from institution concerned to prove the equivalency at the time of verification, then only such qualification shall be treated as equivalent to the prescribed qualification.
- 6) In the case of difference in original caste/ community claimed in the application and that entered in the SSLC book, the candidate shall produce Gazette Notification in this regard, along with non-creamy layer/ community certificate at the time of certificate verification.
- 7) Communication to the candidates: All notifications and updates regarding the recruitment process, including exam schedules, admit cards, interview dates and final result will be published in the official website of LBS Centre for Science and Technology and Kerala State Science and Technology Museum. Candidates are advised to check the websites regularly. No separate communication will be sent via post
- 8) All the original documents to prove claims of reservations and

relaxation in upper age limit shall be produced at the time of certificate verification.

9) The last date and time of submitting online application shall be 20/01/2026 up to 12 midnight.

III. General conditions of Appointment

- 1) Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Communities, differentially abled and Ex-service men categories are eligible for relaxation in upper age limit as per the norms as followed by the Kerala P.S.C. for Direct Recruitment in Government services.
- 2) Candidates applying for the post should have attained the prescribed qualifications on or before the closing date of online submission of application.
- 3) Examination (OMR based) will be conducted Thiruvananthapuram only.
- 4) No TA/DA will be paid for the tests.
- 5) The benefits which are not claimed in the submitted online application form will not be considered later.
- 6) Selected candidates will have to work anywhere within Kerala in any institution under Kerala State Science and Technology Museum.

IV Method of Selection, Appointment and Validity of rank list

1. Objective Type test

An Objective Type Test (OMR based) will be conducted for all the candidates who submitted valid application and a short list of provisionally eligible candidates, subject to the verification of original documents, shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the objective type test.

2. Interview

Interview shall be conducted for all categories for those candidates who are short listed on the basis of the objective type test for the respective post.

3. Appointment

Candidates will be appointed from the rank list against the existing vacancies, during the validity period of the rank list, following the Rules of Reservation and Rotation as followed by Kerala Public Service Commission.

4. Validity of Rank Lists

Rank list shall be valid for a period of 1 (one) year from the date of publishing.

V. Mode of submitting the Online Applications.

- Candidates can apply for the posts through the online link

“www.kstmuseum.com and www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in”

- A valid mobile number is required for online registration for sending the registration details/ instructions. Candidates applying for more than one post shall use the same mobile number for registration.
- Candidate should upload his/her recent passport size photograph (taken within 6 months), signature and all relevant certificates to prove date of birth, qualification, experience if required for the post, community, non-creamy layer, disability etc.
- Application fee will be collected through online mode only.
- Valid Aadhar number shall be entered in the application. The candidates shall produce the original Aadhar documents for verification and identification of the candidate for the written test, interview and appointment.
- After registration, candidates are advised to keep the printout of the application, Registration ID and Site Access Key for future reference.
- The application will be summarily rejected if non-compliance with the notification is found in due course of processing.
- The date of availability of admission ticket and the date of examination will be published in the Websites,

www.kstmuseum.com and www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in Candidates need to download the admission ticket for the test through online mode only. No admission ticket will be sent to the candidates individually by post. Candidates are advised to visit the above Websites occasionally for further information.
